



2016 Berklee College of Music Graduation Exit Survey Results

In spring 2016, the offices of Alumni Affairs and Institutional Assessment, and the divisions of Student Affairs and Enrollment, partnered to design and administer a short exit survey to graduating students. This survey collected students' permanent contact information and immediate post-graduation plans, and also asked students to assess their experience at Berklee. The survey was distributed to graduating students as they picked up their cap and gown for commencement during the week of April 25, 2016. Two reminder emails were subsequently sent to students who had not yet completed the survey. Of the 922 graduating students, 788 unique responses were collected, resulting in an 86% response rate.

Primary activity after graduation

The results of this survey provide an overview of our 2016 graduating student class. A large majority of students (92%) indicate that their primary activity after graduation is related to music and that they will be in the United States (90%). Slightly more than one-third of students are still seeking employment and another 29% indicate that they will be self-employed. Fourteen percent are employed and 13% are engaged in an internship. Most of those who are employed will be working full time (69%). Only nine students shared their annual salaries; these range from \$27,000 to \$105,000 per year. Thirty-eight students shared their hourly wages which vary from \$15/hour to \$24/hour. The complete list of employers appears in the appendix.

Experience at Berklee

Most students express satisfaction with their academic and overall experience at Berklee (86% extremely satisfied/somewhat satisfied) and with the time it took them to complete their degree (81%). There is less satisfaction with how Berklee prepared them for the next stage in their career (74%) and with the support services offered while at Berklee (68%). Ninety percent express a likelihood to recommend Berklee to others.
