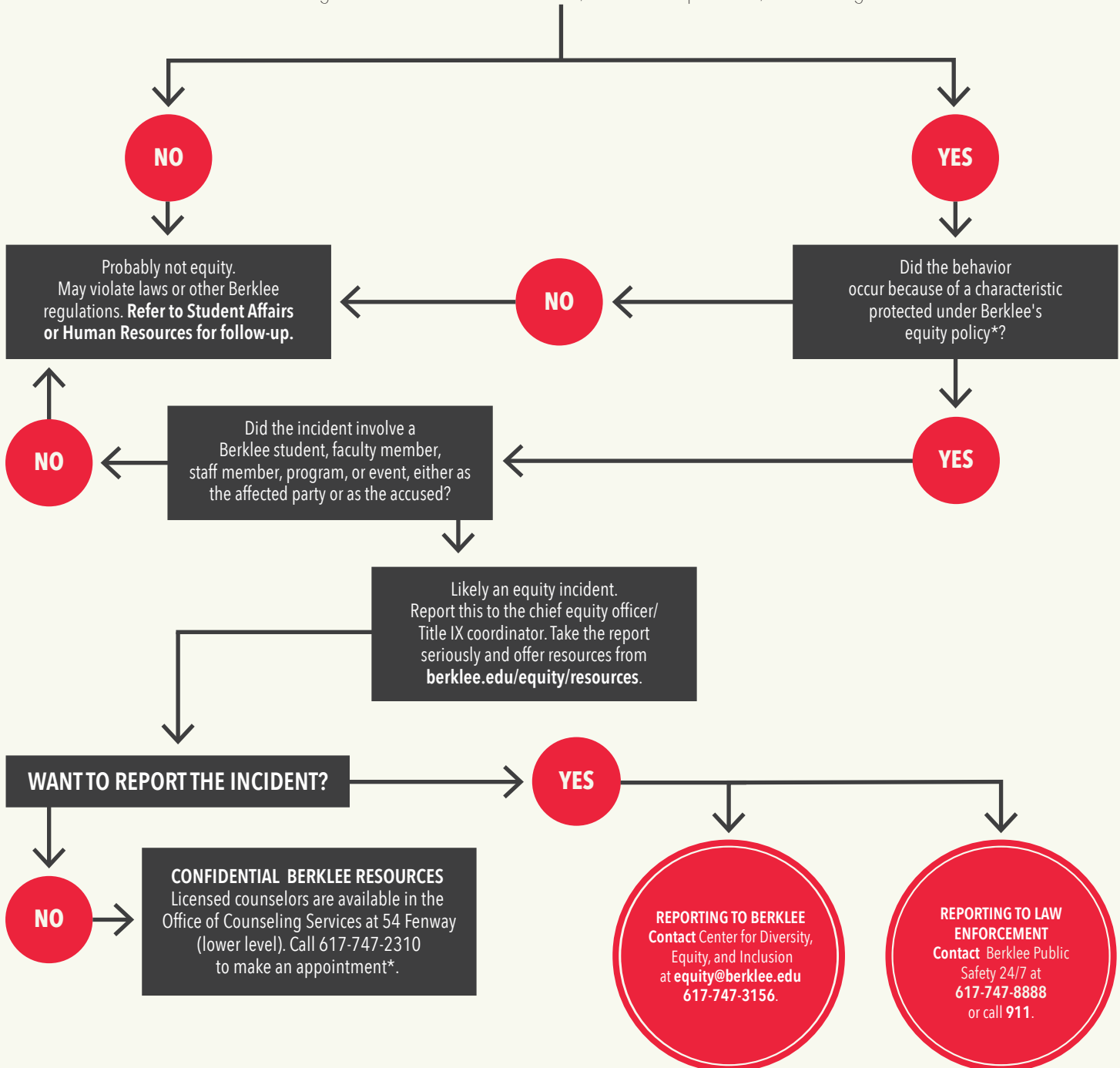


IS IT EQUITY?

Does the incident involve discrimination, harassment, or sexual misconduct, including sexual assault/harassment, relationship abuse, or stalking?



REMEMBER

- Don't ask detailed questions to the person who disclosed; just help them and report what you know.
- Berklee's policy does not limit when someone can report an incident.
- Berklee's policy can address incidents that occur off-campus and online.
