# **INTERNATIONAL STUDENT I-20 REQUEST PACKET**

Congratulations on your acceptance to Berklee, and welcome to our community. We are here to answer questions you may have about being a student at Berklee and living in the U.S.

International students who wish to study in the U.S. need to obtain F-1 student status - the immigration status that will allow them to enroll as full-time students. You will first need to get an <u>I-20</u> from Berklee, pay the required I-901 fee (paid after you have the I-20) and then apply for an <u>F-1 visa</u> from the <u>U.S. embassy or consulate</u> in your home country. These documents together will allow you to enter the U.S. in F-1 status.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

This packet is designed to walk you step-by-step through understanding and completing the I-20 request process.

**Entering / new students:** You must submit your tuition deposit before requesting your I-20. Follow the instructions provided by Admissions to accept your offer of admission and pay your tuition deposit.

# 1. GATHER DOCUMENTS AND COMPLETE THE REQUIRED SECTIONS OF THIS PACKET

Follow the I-20 Request Packet Checklist below.

#### 2. SUBMIT YOUR COMPLETE I-20 REQUEST PACKET AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

Use the <u>I-20 Request Submission Form</u> to submit your completed packet and supporting documents to International Student Services (ISS). Refer to the checklist below. Requests submitted via email will not be processed.

#### 3. WAIT TO RECEIVE YOUR I-20 VIA EMAIL

**Entering/new students:** Your I-20 will be sent to the email address provided within this packet. **Continuing and returning students:** Your I-20 will be sent to your berklee.edu email address.

#### 4. AFTER YOU RECEIVE YOUR I-20, PAY THE I-901 SEVIS FEE ONLINE

You need your I-20 in order to pay the I-901 SEVIS fee. Payment instructions will be included with your I-20. Do not attempt to pay the SEVIS fee until you receive your I-20.

### 5. AFTER YOU PAY THE I-901 SEVIS FEE, SCHEDULE YOUR F-1 VISA INTERVIEW

at the <u>U.S. embassy or consulate</u> in your home country. (Note: Canadian or Bermudian passport holders are not required to apply for an F-1 visa. You will need to present your passport, I-20, I-901 SEVIS fee payment receipt, and supporting financial documentation at the U.S. port of entry in order to be admitted to the U.S. in F-1 status.)

# **I-20 REQUEST PACKET CHECKLIST**

When your request packet is complete, use the I-20 Request Submission Form to submit your completed packet and supporting documents .

#### **REQUIRED FOR ALL STUDENTS:**

- 1. Student Information for I-20 form (page 4).
- 2. Affidavit of Support, completed by each financial sponsor (page 5).
- **3. Evidence of Funding:** submit a bank letter/statement, award letter, and English translation (if necessary) for *each* financial sponsor.
- **4. Passport:** submit a copy of the biographical page(s) of your passport, showing your photo, personal information, and expiration date.

# SUBMIT THESE ITEMS ONLY IF THEY APPLY TO YOU:

Page 7: <u>Dependent Information Form</u>, completed.

- **1. Dependent's passport:** submit a copy of the biographical page(s) of your dependent's passport, showing photo, personal information, and expiration date.
- 2. For dependent spouse: submit a copy of your marriage certificate (with word-for-word translation if not in English).
- **3. For each dependent child:** submit a copy of your child's birth certificate (with word-for-word translation if not in English).

#### ABOUT THE COST OF ATTENDANCE

In order for Berklee to issue an I-20, students are required to submit evidence of funding to the school proving you have access to funds which will cover at least one year of educational and living expenses. The information your provide will appear on your I-20. You will need to present the same evidence of funding during your F-1 visa interview.

The cost of attendance includes both direct expenses like tuition, health insurance and fees charged by Berklee, and indirect expenses such as standard estimates for housing, meals, books and supplies, travel, and incidental expenses. This is an estimate – actual expenses may vary depending on the student's choice of housing and lifestyle.

F-1 visa regulations do not permit students to <u>work</u> <u>off campus</u> (playing gigs, self employment or working for an employer located outside the U.S., etc.) during their first year in the U.S.

Moreover, off campus employment options for subsequent years are <u>extremely limited</u>. As a result, U.S. federal immigration regulations require that all F-1 visa applicants prove that they have enough funds for the estimated cost of attendance for one academic year.

#### HOW TO CALCULATE YOUR EXPENSES AND ORGANIZE YOUR EVIDENCE OF FUNDING

#### 1. FIND THE AMOUNT OF FUNDING YOU NEED TO DOCUMENT

Find the amount of funding you need to document based on your academic your program on the chart above.

#### 2. DETERMINE YOUR FUNDING SOURCES

Typically, students have the following funding sources: a College/Conservatory scholarship, personal funds, family funds, or private/government scholarships.

#### 3. COLLECT EVIDENCE OF FUNDING

<u>Page 3</u> includes a list of required documents for each type of funding, a sample bank letter, and a list of documents that are not acceptable for I-20 purposes. Read the documentation requirements carefully and share them with your financial sponsor(s) and/or bank.

# **EVIDENCE OF FUNDING**

The financial documentation requirements defined here for I-20 issuance are the same as those established by the U.S. Department of State for granting an F-1 visa. All evidence of funding must meet the criteria listed under "Acceptable Evidence of Funding".

	First Year Abroad, continuing, and returning students: Submit a copy of your award letter.	
PERSONAL FUNDS	A letter from your bank or monthly bank statement.	
FAMILY FUNDS/OTHER PRIVATE SPONSOR	A letter or monthly statement from <b>each</b> sponsor's bank and a signed <u>Affidavit of Support.</u>	
GOVERNMENT/OTHER ORGANZATION	An official letter from the sponsoring government/organization. The letter must be signed by an authorized representative, detail the terms of your scholarship/grant, state the duration of the award and include the exact total amount of the scholarship/grant.	
FIRST YEAR ABROAD, CONTINUING, AND RETURNING STUDENTS ONLY:	You may submit proof of your paid tuition bill for the semester you plan to enroll as part of your funding documentation. Submit a screenshot of your student account statement showing the amount paid. You must submit additional funding documents so that your total evidence of funding is equal to or greater than the published cost of attendance.	

#### ACCEPTABLE EVIDENCE OF FUNDING

Evidence of funding must contain all the information listed below. The red numbers on the sample bank letter (right) correspond with each required item in the list below:


- Detailed bank statement(s) or letter from your bank (see sample) that are less than 9 months old.
- (2) Issue date is within nine months of student's I-20 request
- (3) Name of account holder

If the bank letter/statement is for an account held by a business or corporation, provide proof that you or your sponsor may withdraw money from the account. Proof can be in the form of an additional statement on the letter or a separate document showing ownership of the business.

- (4) Type of account
- (5) Account number (last 4 digits of number is sufficient)
- (6) Exact current available balance

If you do not wish to disclose the exact balance in the account, indicate that the current available balance is equal to or greater than the <u>amount you must document</u>. For example: a letter for a student in the bachelor's degree program can state, "...the current available balance is greater than \$82,452 USD."

- (7) Type of currency
- (8) Statement that funds are current and liquid
- (9) If submitting a bank letter, signature of bank official
- (10) If submitting a bank letter, bank stamp/seal
- (11) The letter/monthly statement is written in English
  If the letter/monthly statement is not in English, you
  may submit a word-for-word translation with the
  original-language document. An official translation is
  not required; you can complete the word-for-word
  translation yourself.



# UNACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTS AND FUNDING SOURCES

- Any document that is dated more than nine months prior to your I-20 request.
- Screenshots or printouts of an online account taken directly from the browser window.
- Investment accounts such as stocks, lines of credit, bonds, or any other type of investment funds.
- Statements of value for property, land, houses, apartments, or other non-liquid assets.
- Salary, wage, or income statements; tax forms or insurance policies.
